OGDEN – Bud A. Braegger passed on August 22, 2006 at his home in Ogden, Utah at the age of 77.

They made their home in Willard, where they started their family. At that time Bud helped his father on his farm and worked at Hill Air Force Base, then later worked for O.U.R.D. and the Union Railroad. He also owned this own tavern “Bud’s Shack” in Willard.

Like his father he had a love for farming and in 1960 Bud bought a ranch in Star Valley, Wyoming. His parents had already moved to Wyoming earlier and Bud also helped his father with their ranch. While living in Star Valley he also became the town Sheriff. He had a love for the outdoors and the wilderness and later became an outfitter and guide.

After the death of his father Bud sold his ranch and moved back to Ogden in 1969. He then went to work for the Labors Union as a laborer. Bud had a love for gardening and loved to share his vegetables that he grew with his friends and the neighbors. He could strike up a conversation with anyone, and loved to play practical jokes. He also enjoyed collecting antiques.

He is survived by his wife Phylis; one brother Floyd (Claire); three children Philip (Debbie), Shelly Yingst, and Kim (Bill) Kirby; seven grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.
